

The project has **three main intellectual outputs:**


IO1: Digital Breakout Compendium of Resources

IO1: Digital Breakout Compendium of Resources:

We developed several breakouts in different areas: critical and creative thinking, entrepreneurial spirit, digital competence, and media literacy. The resources are available free of charge on the platform, in all partner languages: Bulgarian, Finnish, Greek, Icelandic and Portuguese. The Digital Breakout was developed with the greatest care to have an immersive experience.

IO2: In-service Training Program and Handbook:

Was developed considering the needs of VET tutors and prepares them to use the XCAPE resources and create their own resources and digital breakouts.

The in-service training programme is available online as a handbook in pdf format for printing and as a flip-book for online use.
